## USE TO DEVELOP:

- ⇒ Oral language/English language
- ⇒ Sorting skills
- ⇒ Initial/final sound awareness
- ⇒ Syllabication
- ⇒ Alphabetical order

## SUGGESTIONS:

- ⇒ Have students bring items to add to buckets - discussion around “where to place them” or bring for specific sound
- ⇒ Take the bucket that matches the letter your name starts with— explore & discuss—work through letters in your name or friends names
- ⇒ Have students create labels for buckets
- ⇒ Sort items in a bucket—discuss your “rule” “living/not living”
- ⇒ Create “words” to match items, or lists to “check” items
- ⇒ Put items from 2 or 3 buckets into pile & sort back to correct bucket
