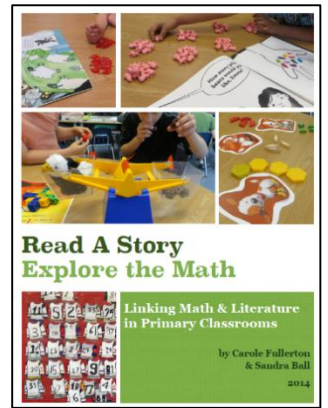

## Read a Story – Explore the Math

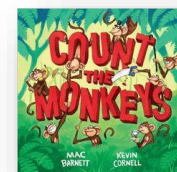
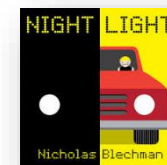
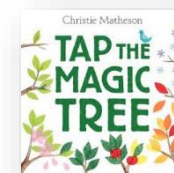


Everyone loves a good story. Teachers love reading them and children love hearing them. What better way to set the stage for a math lesson than through a story?
